ECABC Bulletin: Employers - Apply Now for Canada-BC Job Grant

Applications for the Canada-BC Job Grant (CJG) are now being accepted for training with start dates between January 1st and March 31st, 2017.

What is the Canada-B.C. Job Grant?

The Canada-B.C. Job Grant (CJG) is an employer-driven, cost-sharing program that helps employers invest in training for their current or future employees. The CJG assists eligible employers to offset the cost of training up to a maximum of \$10,000 per participant per fiscal year. The employer contributes at least one-third to the cost of training. The employer must have a job for the participant at the end of training.

The goals of the CJG are to increase participation of British Columbians in the labour force by helping them develop the skills they need to find and keep a job. The CJG is also an opportunity for employers to invest in training that is better aligned to job opportunities. Please refer to CJG criteria to fully understand the eligibility requirements of the program before you apply. The application window will remain open until subscription targets have been met.
